Nominations for each of the three candidates below (numbered 1 to 3), were received from IITPSA members, each of them having been formally, correctly and timeously lodged with the Institute.

Candidate 1 – Prof. Lynn Futcher



Affiliation: Nelson Mandela University, Port Elizabeth, South Africa

Prof Futcher is currently an Associate Professor of the School of IT (SoIT), Faculty of Engineering, the Built Environment and Technology (EBET), at the Nelson Mandela University based in Port Elizabeth, South Africa. In addition, she is the Head of Department for the Department of Information Management and Governance and

coordinator of the MPhil in IT Governance qualification.

Prof Futcher has a PhD in Information Technology. Her primary areas of research include Information and Cyber Security Education and Secure Software Development and as such is a key member of the Nelson Mandela University's Centre for Research in Information and Cyber Security (CRICS). She also has a keen interest in IT Project Management, Human Computer Interaction, User Experience and Usable Security.

Prof Futcher has been actively involved in the IFIP Working Group 11.8 (Information Security Education) since 2005 which aims to promote Information Security Education, Training and Awareness in academia, government and industry by encouraging collaboration and engagement amongst these key stakeholders. She has taken on several IFIP WG11.8 committee positions including Chair (2014 to 2020), Vice-Chair (2005 to 2011) and Secretary (2011 to 2014). In 2020 she was nominated as a specialist member to IFIP TC11, the technical committee for Security and Privacy Protection in Information Processing Systems.

Prof Futcher is also currently the Chair of the Eastern Cape Chapter of the IITPSA, and an active member of the Women in IT Chapter.
