CEO'S COMMUNIQUE

As a membership-based organisation, one of the IITPSA's most important measures of how well we are doing is our membership numbers. As I reflected in my report during our recent AGM, we saw some decline in membership during the pandemic. There has also been an increase in migration, with some of our younger members seeking work abroad – and finding it. The Institute has a solid and increasingly young and dynamic member base. Indeed, 68% of our membership is in the 26 – 40 age group, and a growing proportion of our members are women.

Although the decline we experienced during Covid is turning, we would like to drive significant growth in our numbers – particularly in under-represented regions. It should be noted that IITPSA members can be the Institute's best – or worst – ambassadors. As a member, you can help increase awareness, grow positive opinion of the Institute and strengthen our ranks. If every member brought another member on board, we would have a stronger voice and even greater impact.

Our members must be seen to be shining examples of ethical, professional behaviour, and should evangelise the benefits of belonging to the IITPSA.

IOI team competes in Hungary

The South African team competing in the 35th International Olympiad in Informatics (IOI 2023) is currently in Szeged, Hungary, for the prestigious event.

The team, comprising Minkyum Kim and Youkyum Kim of Reddam House Durbanville, Muhammad Shah Khan of the UJ Metropolitan Academy, and Benjamin Kleyn of Parel Vallei High will participate in IOI 2023 until 4 September. The IOI is an annual international informatics competition for high school students from various invited countries. It is one of the five international science Olympiads and is regarded as one of the most prestigious competitive programming events in the world.

Team SA was selected from the top performers in the Programming Olympiad, an initiative of the IITPSA sponsored by Jane Street.

The 2023 Programming Olympiad, which invites schools across the country to participate, enjoyed increased participation this year. This year, 1694 learners from 136 schools participated, up from 1612 learners who participated the year before.



Pr.CIOs review the pros and cons of cloud in SA

While there are some compelling benefits of moving to the cloud, cloud adoption is also causing headaches for CIOs, who must grapple with major vendors going all-cloud, cost spikes driving repatriation from the cloud, and unexpected business risks.

APPLICATIONS OLYMPIAD: STUDENT PROFILE



Lara Lategan

Lara Lategan, a Grade 12 learner at Hoërskool Randburg in Gauteng, was among the top performers in this year's IITPSA Applications Olympiad. The Olympiad is part of the Computer Olympiad, which is one of the oldest and biggest events of its kind in the world. First launched in 1984, the event engages over 50,000 participants annually.

The Applications Olympiad is a challenge for those who take CAT or the ICDL or are otherwise computer literate. Participants must solve a number of problems using a Microsoft Office package and the data provided. They may use the application of their choice, such as the Word Processor, Spreadsheet, Database and Presentation Tool.

Lara, who won a bronze medal in the Olympiad, plans to complete a BAcc degree at Stellenbosch University and work towards becoming a chartered accountant. Commenting on the benefits of participating in the Olympiad, she says: "I have learned many new computer skills that I will be able to apply to my future career path." Lara's other interests include learning new languages, reading and exercising to relieve stress.

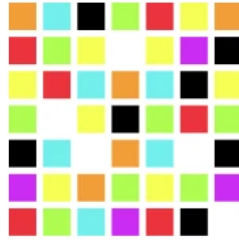
